

Why are we demonstrating in Heidelberg?

Since 24.09.2015 a registration centre for refugees has been operating in the area of the former US barracks Patrick Henry Village. Reception and registration centres, as they were developed in Heidelberg and other places, are a crucial point in the aggravation of the asylum law. The Heidelberg pilot project is aiming to decide within 24-48 hours. Refugees are becoming vitreous, transparent humans. The arrival pass also records data without any importance for the asylum procedure. People seeking for shelter are sorted and sorted out into four groups with a cynical calculation of their economic and political use. Those who are not allowed to stay, for example because they are coming from supposedly safe countries of origin, are being deported immediately and exposed to renewed persecution. Those affected are among others Roma. Special laws for migrants and refugees are manifestations of the oppression through state racism, which the affected people are experiencing day-to-day. They are talking about integration while working on the more and more spreading social exclusion of refugees. We decisively have to fight against this!

The registration centre has to be abolished immediately! No lager, no deportation! Solidarity with all refugees! Same rights and the same right to a good life for all humans!

Against all forms of racism and outlawing! Let's unite and join forces! Aggravations of the asylum laws, the extension of the list of „safe countries of origin“, or the EU-Turkey-Deal at the expense of refugees could be enforced with barely any resistance. That's why we currently find a joined platform of discussions and actions indispensable.
